


# Park Street/Campanelli Park Sewer Expansion Project

Public Meeting June 22nd, 7:00 p.m. at Town Hall



## Background:

- ◆ In 2012 a Citizen's Petition was submitted to the Board of Selectmen by Park Street/Campanelli Park Area Property Owners requesting that the Town fund a sewer expansion project; Town Meeting voted against the project
- ◆ During 2015 the Town Engineer worked with a consultant to prepare a Town wide Sewer Area Ranking Plan; the Park Street/Campanelli Area was ranked as the #1 priority area; plan was presented to and endorsed by BOS on December 15, 2015
- ◆ On April 26th the Town Engineer presented draft Sewer Betterment & Connection Policies to the BOS (BOS Meetings can be viewed on-line at Stoughton Media Access Corporation under Video On Demand -Meetings)

## Purpose of Meeting:

- ◆ There is still a need for sewer expansion in this area and a desire by many property owners
- ◆ Engineering Department is proposing connecting approximately 300 homes and businesses to public sewer, installing 34,000 feet of municipal sewer and two wastewater pump stations
- ◆ Town Officials and experts will be at the meeting to inform the public and answer questions about the proposed Sewer Expansion Project and a new potential funding mechanism known as Chapter 23L
- ◆ Property owners can find out how concerns/obstacles from 2012 have been addressed
- ◆ Property owners will be presented with the estimated cost for them to take part in Chapter 23L vs. the cost of doing nothing
- ◆ Property owners interested in moving forward with the project and Chapter 23L can sign a Citizen's Petition that is being circulated by fellow property owner, Paul Carter
