Stoughton Business and Permitting Guide Launched

A new Economic Development tool is now available for the Town of Stoughton which is a Business and Permitting Guide. The purpose of this guide is to serve as a marketing tool to attract new businesses to the Town of Stoughton and to serve as a “How To” open a business in the town guide. The guide was developed by the Director of Economic Development with assistance from the Metropolitan Area Planning Council utilizing a District Local Technical Assistance (DLTA) Grant from the State. The guide contains useful information including key contacts, maps, resources for business start-up and expansion, workforce development and training information, required licenses and permits, local amenities, etc. The guide also includes a form that allows businesses to request meetings with the appropriate town staff that will be coordinated by the Director of Economic Development, Pamela McCarthy.
