What Is a Site Finder?

A site finder is a tool that can be used to list available sites in a particular area (in this case the Town of Stoughton) and to request information about sites including existing ones and future sites that meet your requirements as they become available. This is a tool that is already being used at the State level by MassEcon called Ready Mass 100 which helps attract major businesses to the State. A site finder is not a tool typically found at the municipal level. In order to make it easier to market and find sites in the Town of Stoughton the Town's Economic Development Director has teamed up with Old Colony Planning Council to create our own.

What Will Happen at the Launch?

There will be a demonstration of the Site Finder by the Town's Economic Development Director, Pamela McCarthy and GIS Expert, Laurence Langlois. You will leave the meeting knowing how to submit a site or a request for site information and you will know how to use the mapping tools that will show site details such as zoning and proximity to transportation.
