## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:**

**Adult Ceramics:** Veteran Ceramic Instructor Denise Wallace brings many years of ceramic expertise to this eight week course. Students will work on and complete several projects of their choice. Instruction as well as greenware, glazes, paints, and firing are included in this class. Students are responsible for their own brushes, ceramic tools, and electrical hardware. **Projects selected must be completed before moving on to the next project.** Limitation on projects is at instructor's discretion.

**Children's Halloween Jewelry Workshop:** Join us for exciting Halloween workshop. Children will make earrings, bracelets and pendants in this hour long workshop. Beads are hand blown glass and come in a variety of Halloween shapes. **ALL MATERIALS ARE INCLUDED.**

**Holiday Boxwood Tree Workshop:** This boxwood tree centerpiece will make any mantle or table a show piece. Learn to make this natural festive tree and learn decorative tips from crafter Laurice Rubel. All Materials are included.

**Creative Cupcakes** : Tired of everyone bringing the same boring cupcakes to every event? Now is your chance to stand out and have your cupcakes be a hit! Instructor Carolyn LaMore will host a fun and creative class on the art of decorating cupcakes. Each week cupcakes will be explored with different themes and designs including: holiday, birthday, seasonal cupcakes, and more. There are not your average cupcakes but "mini works of art."
