COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL: MINIMUM PERMIT.....

All commercial work to be charged 2% of the electrical cost per job unless listed below.

Retro Fit.....First 50 fixtures..... \$ .75 each

Retro Fit.....51 and over..... \$ .45 each

Electric Signs and marquee installations.....\$75.00

Neon Sign and outline.....\$75.00

Carnival - per ride and/or booth.....\$25.00

Repair and maintenance permit:.....Annual Fee...\$100.00

Industrial concerns employing a licensed electrician on their staff may take out permit for repair and maintenance work only on their premises. Unless equipment is the direct replacement of existing machinery the fee shall be in accordance with other sections of this fee schedule.
