Rules and Regulations

Trash Regulations

- All rubbish must be set neatly at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- Rubbish Collection is provided once a week to each residential address in town. Changes in schedule (holidays, etc.) will be advertised locally.
- If a holiday falls on your collection day, rubbish will be picked up on the next working day.
- Holidays are as follows: New Years Day, M.L. King Day, Washington's Birthday, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
- Rubbish which is not at curbside when the truck reaches that location will not be collected later.
- Rugs/carpet must be cut into widths of no more than 4' and tied into rolls of no more than 12" in diameter for collection at curbside. Same with lumber/wood.
- No barrel over 30 gallon-sizes will be emptied.
- Bags & boxes torn, broken, or water-soaked due to weather, will be the responsibility of the homeowner. Same with plastic containers that are broken damaged.
- Mattresses: Twin & full w/box spring; queen & king 1 piece per week.

- **Large household metal appliances** must be called in to the Public Works Dept. for an appointment to be picked up, or can be brought to the Recycling Center (call the PWD for more information).
- Multiple dwelling units of more than 3 families will not be collected.
- TVs and computer monitors will be picked up at curbside by appointment only. You can no longer bring TVs or computer monitors to the Transfer Station.
