March 1, 2023

The Committee held a meeting at the Library on March 1, 2023 commencing at 7:00 pm. In attendance were Nathan Cleveland, Chair, Dave Billo, Vice-Chair, and members Arthur Rigor da Eva and Molly Cochran.

The Committee approved the meeting minutes for January 18, February 1, and February 15, 2023.

Nathan reported that the Technical Assistance Program (TAP) grant application has been submitted as of March 1st to the Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC). It was sent with a letter of support from the Town Manager.

Nathan reported that a new Town website is being rolled out. He was able to get the Committee website updated to reflect current members, meeting dates, and updated goals. Once the new Town website is launched, he will revisit the Committee's ability to make updates itself.


