Jack Erickson, ADA Coordinator has been provided information regarding Self Evaluation and Transition plans.

This Commission continues to plan for a program on SMAC television. We will attempt to complete this by 6/30/23. Michael Hardman will continue to work on this and develop a script

At present, the Commonwealth has not finalized requirements for in-person vs. remote meetings under the ongoing Covid pandemic measures. When that information is released, plans will be made for either an in-person or remote meetings beginning in April.
