The Treasurer/Collector, Paula Nute, is announcing that the **\$15.00 demand fee will be added to the unpaid real estate and personal property tax bills on May 22, 2023**. The demand bill will be due June 5, 2023, and interest of 14% has accrued on the outstanding balances that were due August 1, 2022, November 1, 2022, February 1, 2023 (personal property only) and May 1, 2023.

When sending payment(s) to the Lockbox address in Medford, checks AND tax remittances MUST BE SENT. PLEASE do not send checks only to the Medford address. If there is no remittance with the check(s) the payment cannot be processed and will be returned to Town Hall for processing. This may delay the payment from being applied to your tax bill.

When processing a payment online through your bank, you MUST include the bill number, and the year and type in the Memo field (for example, Bill #25, 2023 real estate or personal property) so your payment will be properly applied. When processing multiple bills, you must include each bill number. If this information is not on your check, the check may be returned to you. **Online bank payment checks must be mailed to** Town of Stoughton PO Box 9108 Stoughton MA 02072.

For your convenience, there is a secured payment drop box outside Town Hall on Pearl St. The payment drop box is emptied two to three times a day, once in the morning and once in the afternoon, and if needed, once before leaving for the day.
