Online Stoughton Vital Records

Town and vital records ca. 1717-1886, Stoughton, Massachusetts. This digital collection from FamilySearch.org is from microfilm produced at Stoughton Town Hall in 1973 of Original records. Contains births, marriages, and deaths for 1717-1860, marriage intentions (1717-1886), certificates of religious society membership (1821-1823), pre-Stoughton precinct records (1715-1726), and town records (town meeting minutes, votes, etc., 1726-1772).

Starting in 1841 the Commonwealth of Massachusetts required every town and city clerk to send a copy of their Births, Marriages and Deaths. The first few years in the 1840's births were statistical returns.
